We trust our mail finds you and your families well.

We were happy to hear, during the 100th Anniversary broadcast, the statements given by the President of the State of Israel and the Minister of Culture and Sports, that in summer 2022 the Maccabiah will take place and that there is and will be full support from the Israeli Government.

As a part of the preparations for the Maccabiah, we established a new committee that will deal with all matters concerning Covid-19 guidelines & outline. The committee will be under the Maccabiah Operations Division, together with representatives of the Ministry of Culture and Sports & the Ministry of Health, and we will discuss there the outline and plan of action together.

We are studying the situation of vaccines in each of the countries and are examining the possibility of finding solutions in countries where there is a shortage of vaccines.

The Maccabiah headquarters will recommend to all countries to send only vaccinated or recovering athletes. The same is applied to all athletes' members of the Israeli delegation.

Our goal is to try to create a vaccination option for each athlete participating in the Maccabiah.

The Israeli laws and regulations during the Maccabiah are the ones that will determine the manner in which Maccabiah athletes & guests are treated, and according to which we will act. The Maccabiah will operate a system of rapid tests in full cooperation with the health officials in Israel and will operate to be the safest Maccabiah.

If the Maccabiah will be canceled due to Covid-19, all advance payments will be returned to the delegations.

We urge you to please continue preparing for the Maccabiah in 2022, and we are confident that together we will succeed in fulfilling the task of executing the most successful, safe, and largest Maccabiah.
